



NOTES ABOUT EQUIPMENT

Each year teams will receive jerseys for their team.

It is the responsibility of the team to ensure that these jerseys are well cared for so that they will last for years to come. To that end, we offer the following tips:

- ✓ Team jerseys should be used for games only. Players are responsible to supply their own practice jersey.
- ✓ Jerseys should be folded on the top of the player`s equipment bag to avoid being cut by skates or otherwise damaged.
- ✓ Anything added to jerseys must be removed before they are returned at the end of the season. Name bars and letters C or A are to be stitched on and in no case ironed on.
- ✓ Nothing other than name bars of letters C or A are to be attached to the team jerseys without the permission of the CORA executive. This includes team sponsor name or information.
- ✓ Jerseys are to be washed prior to being returned at the end of the season.

Additionally, each team will receive a supply of rings, approximately one per player, at the beginning of the season. These also have to be returned to the equipment manager at the end of the season. Teams are responsible to replace any rings lost or stolen during the season.
